BI-COUNTY STOCK SHOW

If you are showing livestock at the Bi-County Stock Show next week, this rule is for you:

General Rule #13: Exhibitors in the Bi-County Jr. Livestock Show must be present at a minimum of one workday or cleanup day or they will forfeit \$50.00. Sign-up sheets will be provided at workdays for record keeping purposes. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to sign the sign-up sheet for proof of attendance.

Stock Show Work days have been scheduled for:

SET UP - Monday, January 11 – 4:30pm to distribute shavings

CLEAN UP - Friday, January 15 - after the swine show to clean up the arena and set up the sale ring

CLEAN UP – Saturday, January 16 – after the sale to disassemble the sale ring and cleanup before the dance

RABBIT EXHIBITORS

Mandatory meeting concerning rabbit cleanup workday; Thursday, January 14th @ 6:30 pm at the coliseum in the rabbit area.

Please check your rabbit for ear mites. NO rabbit will be allowed in the barn with ear mites. If they have ear mites, please call the vet.
