SWINE TAG ORDERS FOR STATE FAIR 2016 ONLY: Tag orders are due to the Extension office by 5pm on Wednesday, April 8th. These are for State Fair only!! Tags are \$11.00

STEER STATE TAG ORDERS FOR 2016-2017: Tag orders are due to the Extension Office by Monday, April 11th. These tags are for any steer to be shown at any major stock show, state fair and bi-county. State tags are \$11.00 and county tags are \$1.00.

LAMB & GOAT TAG ORDERS DUE FOR STATE FAIR 2016: Tag orders are due to the Extension Office by Monday, April 11th. These are tags for State Fair only. Tags are \$11.00.

HEIFER UIN'S: Orders are due to the Extension Office by Monday, April 11th. There is a fee for the UIN barcodes that are attached to your heifer's paperwork. Therefore, each UIN is \$11.00.
