VALIDATION TAGS FOR LIVESTOCK

Unfortunately the state increased the cost this year. \$16

- The payment must be in our office by April 10th
- You may call and tell Bailee how many tags you need anytime between now and April 10th
- Because of the price increase the county will be buying extremely few extra tags
- ONLY pigs showing at THE STATE FAIR OF TEXAS need these tags
- Steers showing at STATE FAIR, FT. WORTH, SAN ANTONIO, SAN ANGELO, HOUSTON, OR AUSTIN need these tags
- Goats & Lambs showing at STATE FAIR OF TEXAS need these tags
- Heifers showing at THE STATE FAIR OF TEXAS, not already validated need to order a UIN.
- There will be another heifer validation in the fall.

VALIDATION FOR HORSE

Validation will be open March 1^{st} – May 1^{st} , at \$10 per validation until April 15^{th} and \$20 from April 16 until May 1

- Horses must be validated in 4-H Connect every year.
- Only one validation per horse each year is necessary (horses do not need to be validated under each siblings name)
- If the horse is registered then the registration papers must be uploaded during validation. The uploaded papers must be legible and the owner must be listed as the 4-Her, or a member of the 4-Hers immediate family (parent, sibling, grandparent, legal guardian). A bill of sale or a signed transfer request will NOT suffice. Families should apply for and receive the corrected papers prior to uploading in 4-H Connect.
- If the horse is grade (unregistered) then the field designated for the upload of registration papers should be left blank.
- Pictures need to be a visual representation of the horses color and markings (head and legs must be visible in right and left profile images and lighting should be sufficient to determine coat color)

Attached are instructions on how to validate your horse by yourself on 4-H connect or you may bring registration papers and pictures to the office and we will help you validate the horse through 4-H Connect.

Theme: For 2017 the theme is "Reflections". These are photos shot off any natural or artificial reflective surface. A well-executed shot will be able to show perfect symmetry or a slightly distorted shot. Examples of photographs in the theme would be, but not limited to, photos from lakes, a window pane, a mirror, or a polished/wax car. 4-H members are encouraged to be creative when thinking about reflections in everyday life and where they are seen.

Changes to rules for 2017. Photos must be 8X10 in size with a quality resolution. Over the past two years the majority of disqualification in the contest have occurred when the photography is too small to be viewed by the judge when downloaded from 4-H CONNECT.
