Location: Amarillo Gun Club, 4521 S. Osage St., Amarillo, TX., 806-372-0678. The Amarillo Gun Club is located 2 miles south of I-40, please use the Ross/Osage exit - 1-40, exit #71.

Registration: **Deadline midnight June 3, 2022** via 4-H Online. **No late entries!**

Registration fees: \$10 per shooter, per event

Additional costs: Round Fees for Trap and Skeet are due UPON REGISTRATION.

Junior Trap Round Fee: \$20

Intermediate Trap Round Fee: \$30

Senior Trap Round Fee: \$40

Junior Skeet Round Fee: \$20

Intermediate Skeet Round Fee: \$30

Senior Skeet Round Fee: \$40

Schedule: Skeet (June 24th) – Check in BEGINS at 9:30 am.

Orientation 10:15 – Immediately begin shooting

Trap (June 25th) – Check in BEGINS at 8:30

Orientation 9:15 – Immediately begin shooting

Awards: **Skeet Awards will be given at the conclusion of Skeet.**

Trap & Overall Awards will be given at the conclusion of Trap.

- Trap & Skeet number of targets: Jr. 50 targets - Int. 75 targets - Sr. 100 targets.
- **High Overall Award will be given for each age division. Must shoot both events.**
- Management reserves the right to move shooters to open fields as needed.
- Leaders from each county will be asked to help!
- Shooters will be squadded in the order in which registration is received.
- No protest will be acknowledged without a \$100 protest fee and no discussions about a protest will be held on the range in front of the youth members. **No Discussion.**
- **Shooters need to bring their own guns and ammunition, ear, and eye protection.** There will be no ammunition for sale at the sites. Eye and ear protection required.
